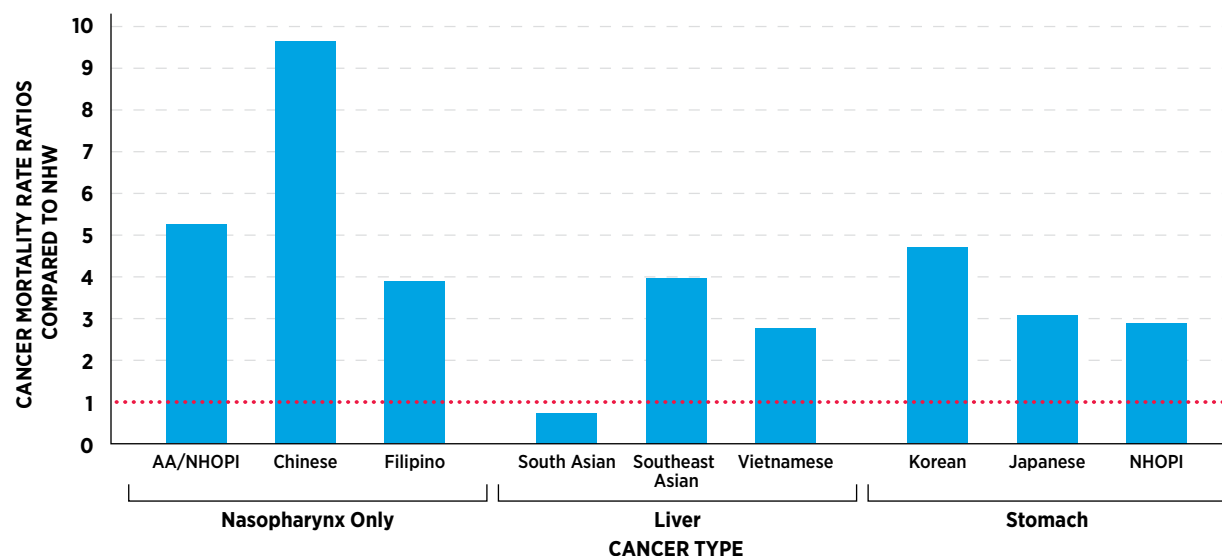

## Varied Burden of Cancer Within the Asian American, Native Hawaiian or Other Pacific Islander (AA/NHOPI) Population



The Asian American and NHOPI population groups are highly distinct and diverse, and represent individuals from different countries of origin, cultures, races and/or ethnicities. However, data related to the cancer burden in the two groups are often aggregated in most cancer databases and registries, making it difficult to accurately

ascertain the burden of cancer within the two population groups. The bar graph shows ratios of mortality rate for the most common cause of cancer-related deaths in various subgroups within the two populations compared to the non-Hispanic White population (shown as the horizontal red dotted line) in California during 2012-2017.
