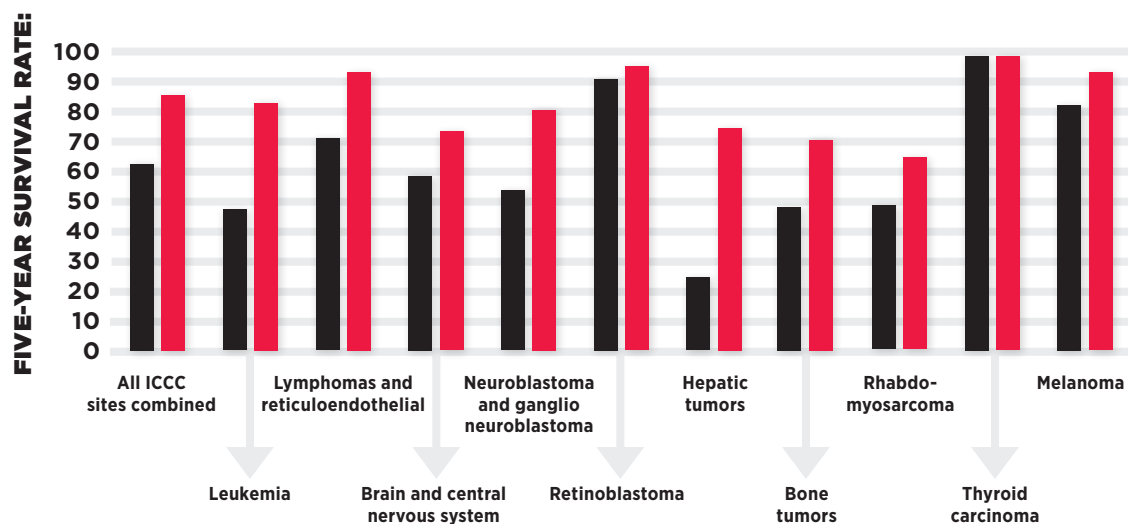


FIGURE 1 MAKING PROGRESS AGAINST CHILDHOOD CANCER



Five-year relative survival rates for U.S. children and adolescents (ages 0-19) diagnosed with cancer from 2010 to 2016 (red bars) were markedly higher than those for U.S. children and adolescents diagnosed from 1975 to 1979 (black bars). Cancers in

children and adolescents are classified using the International Classification of Childhood Cancers (ICCC). The improvement in 5-year relative survival rate was seen for all ICC sites combined, for groups of cancers considered together, and for individual types of cancer.
